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Ms caitie's classroom

Try them out in the comfort of your own home or classroom, and have a blast! In this episode, we're buzzing with excitement as we delve into the amazing world of honey bees. These incredible insects play a vital role in our ecosystem by helping plants grow fruits and veggies that we love to eat. Not to mention, they produce delicious honey! Honey bees communicate through dance and work together as a team to keep their hive thriving. Let's learn more about these busy bees at home by recreating some of the fun activities from our classroom. The activity we used was inspired by bath toys, with test tubes containing colored water and foam paper flowers. Each flower had a hole in the middle for the bee to collect nectar from. A silicone ice cube tray was cut into hexagons for the hive, where bees could store their collected nectar. You can recreate this using various items or your own creations. Focus on the bee's journey and fine motor skills while collecting and storing nectar. To adapt this activity, use cups with flowers or colored water, and pour from one container to another. For younger children, you can omit the flower and simply collect colored water. Don't forget to incorporate color vocabulary when using different colored flowers. If concerned about messes, consider bathing time and pouring water into a single container. The Waggle Dance Bees communicate without speaking through dance moves. Watch Caitie's explanation and try it yourself. Bringing the waggle dance to life, play flower hide-and-seek with a hint provided by dancing towards the hidden flower. Visiting an Urban Beehive Field trips allow us to see beehives in cities like Toronto, where we learned about bees and honey from Madison. Even within short distances, different hives produce distinct tasting honeys due to nectar gathered from various flowers. Have a honey taste test with different types of honey to experience the differences. Join Caitie for a fun-filled adventure and follow her actions! Color Match With Bees The bees in the classroom are lost after their busy day. Help Caitie return them to their correct colored hive. This activity is easy to recreate at home, and you can try it with different themes to practice more than just colors. To practice colors, create bees of various hues. You can use cut-out shapes from construction paper or even just colored pom-poms as bees. Then, cut out hexagon shapes from colored construction paper. Place them in front of your little one and have them match the bee with the right colored hive! Try matching letters and words too! Write lower case letters on each bee, and write the uppercase letter on the hive for a fun matching game. You can also practice numbers by putting a number on both the hives and the bees or even try different representations of the number on the bees like dots. Create Your Own Beehive Find out how to make your own beehive and bee craft here! Try using different colored pom-poms for other activities suggested here! Let's Pretend With our book of pretending, we can pretend to be anything like! In this episode, we pretend to be busy buzzing bees. Encourage your little ones to close their eyes and listen to Caitie as she describes what you as a bee is doing. Can you imagine the pictures in your head? If sitting still and closing your eyes is tricky, encourage your little one to act out the scene as Caitie describes it and move to the music! Little ones might also be inspired to draw pictures of the scene from the Let's Pretend book. Give your little one some props to act out the scene. Perhaps using a beehive and bee craft that they made! We hope you have fun singing, playing, learning, and creating!
