Mophie wireless charging pad comes with an output of 7.5 W and charges your device wirelessly but if your Mophie wireless charging pad is not working dont be sad its common and you can fix it. I will give you 10 possible reasons and fixes why your Mophie wireless charging pad is not working. Here are some quick fixes to fix Mophie wireless charging pad not working Use compatible adapter and USB charging cable Place the charging pad on a level surface Place your device on the pad center Use a thin mobile case Now if these steps dont work for you lets go to discuss deeply possible reasons and how you can fix them. I think you need to know some basic steps on how to charge a device wirelessly. Follow these steps to charge your device with Mophie wireless charging pad. Connect your charging pad with a power source. Use the power adapter that duly comes with the charging pad or is compatible with it (having an output of equal to or more than 7.5 W) Place your charging pad on a level surface Place your device in the correct position on the charging pad generally at the center of the charging pad If your Mophie wireless charging pad is not working then first of all try to test your charger and mobile to check which is not working from both. Check your mobile with some other charger to charge it. If it charges then its means your device had no problem. Now try to charge another device with your Mophie wireless charging pad is it charging or not? If it does not charge then your Mophie charging pad is not working properly and you have found what is at fault. Now lets go to fix it. Perhaps your device is charging correctly but when it vibrates on getting notifications, calls it to misplace from the right angle on the charging pad. But dont worry it can be fixed only by enabling do not disturb mode. When you enable it or silence your device then it will remain placed at the exact place where you place it for charging. Sometimes your device is not working properly due to prolong use. It can be fixed by restarting the device before charging. Restarting will refresh your device and it will start working. Here are a few steps to restart your device. Long press the power button till the power menu appears On the power menu, you will see two options Restart and Power Off Simply click on Restart and your device will automatically turn off and turned on back But if you click Power Off your device will be powered off and you can turn on it back by long pressing the power button All done your device is now restarted and ready to charge. Try to charge your device with Mophie wireless charging pad and check if it is working or not. Sometimes restarting the device does not work and you need to reset your device. Here are the steps to reset your iPhone devices. Press and quickly release the volume up button Press and quickly release the volume down button Long press the power button till the Apple logo appears (it may take up to 25 seconds) Now you have done it and try to charge your device. Place it at the center of the Mophie charging pad to check if it is working now or not. Sometimes your device is out of date and is working on an old version of the software. It may be the reason thats why your Mophie wireless charger not working. Dont be annoyed and go to the settings to see if there is any software update pending. If your device needs a software update then try the following tips to update it. Go to settings Find a software update option (Generally at the end of the settings) Click on software update download and install it Now your device is updated and it will work and start charging with your Mophie wireless charging pad. Try to charge your device and check if it is charging. As we already know that wireless charging is slower compared to wired charging. A thicker mobile case may interrupt the charging process and it can slow it or stop it. Therefore check the mobile case you are using at the back of your device. You should not use a mobile case thicker than 5mm during charging. Check if your mobile case is thicker than 5mm then remove it or replace it with another mobile case to charge your mobile properly with Mophie wireless charging pad. Do not connect your mobile phone with your laptop/pc with USB during charging it with Mophie wireless charging pad. Because if your mobile phone is connected to any of the power sources with USB wireless charging will not work. You should have to remove it first from the device and then try to charge it. As you know wireless charging is based on magnetic induction and it will stop if anything of metal attaches to it. You should check your mobile case if there is anything of metal present in the mobile case or you also make sure that your mobile body is not made of metal material. If you have something in your mobile case then remove everything from the mobile case. But if your mobile body is of metallic material then you should only to do that place a small piece of microfiber cloth between your mobile and Mophie wireless charging pad. It will definitely work for you and your device will start charging. Wireless charging needs more power supply compared to wired charging. So your power adapter is the mean thing in wireless charging. Check that are you using the original 7.5W adapter that comes with Mophie wireless charging pad. If you are using some other adapter then change it with the original adapter or any other having output of 7.5W. Also, check the USB charging cable you are using Mophie wireless charging pad. Learn moreREVIEW Yes, there are a ton of charging stands out there for the iPhone. I am a recent iPhone convert. I have been on Android since the beginning and have now been drawn to the dark side. I have wireless chargers from my previous Android life that will charge my iPhone 11 Pro, but I did not have a charger that would charge my phone and future purchase of the Apple watch. When the chance came to review the Mophie three in one charger, I decided to give it a chance and see how well it works.What is it?The Mophie 3-in-1 wireless charger is a charging stand made to charge your iPhone, Apple Watch, Air Pods, and Air Pods Pro all at the same time. The charger features fast charging for your phone by having 7.5 watts of power. I love that it has a stand for the phone and the watch. Both make it very easy to place your device on the charger and not have to hunt and peck around for the correct charging position. I have another cheaper wireless charging device that lets you place the phone flat down on it. I find myself thinking I am charging my phone when I have instead placed it in the wrong position and not getting a charge at all. Placing the phone in a vertical position on the stand means I have yet to miss hitting the proper charging position. The same goes for the watch and iPod case. SetupFrom the whats in the box picture above, you can see the charging stand comes in three pieces. I had to insert the stand for the phone and the stand for the watch charger into the main base.The picture above shows the bottom of the phone base. Its pins and design of the base make it foolproof to insert the stand into the base. It went in place with a satisfying click. This is the picture of the bottom of the watch charger stand. It also clicked in very easily to the base. Both stands were solidly in the base with no wiggles at all. It was a very sturdy setup. This is a picture of the back of the charging stand where you plug in the power cord. It is the only port for the charger. The cord itself is at least five feet long. I have the charging stand sitting on top of a tall bar plugged into a power strip on the floor.PerformanceLet me start off the performance part of the review by again stating that I just came from the Android world. I used to have a Galaxy Note 10 and fast wireless charging was really that. On the iPhone, fast charging I guess is more relative to the past history of the iPhone itself. It took about two hours to get 50% more charge on my phone. I tried this a couple of times and it was consistently around two hours every time. That seems slow to me compared to wireless charging on my Note 10. I know I can get 48% in a half hour using the wired fast charger. That being said, the only time I charge my phone is overnight. I used my husbands Air Pods Pro and his watch to test out the charging on the stand along with my phone. Everything was charged exactly as it should be. It had no trouble charging through either my case which is a Spigen case or my husbands thicker off-brand case shown in the main picture. I was also able to charge my phone in a horizontal position if I placed the back of the phone in the middle of the charging stand. If I was too much to the left or right, it would not charge. I prefer vertical anyway since horizontal tends to block the ease of accessing the watch and Air Pods charging bases.The stand is well built and has a nice heft to it. It does not lend itself to being scooted around on the desk. I also love the look of the stand.What I likeThis is a beautiful charger. It has a really nice weight to it and is well-designed looks and feature-wise.I like that the phone stand makes hitting the sweet spot for charging the phone vertically foolproof.I like that I can charge my watch, Air Pods, and phone all in one place.Two-year warranty from a company with a known history in the US.What needs to be improvedIt has a rather hefty price tag.Apples fast wireless charging is not all it is cracked up to be. I dont think it is a fault of the stand, but an Apple issue.Final thoughtsThis is a really nice stand that does what it says it will. It charges all three devices and looks great doing so. I know you may be able to get a cheaper knock off version of the charger on Amazon, but you dont know how well it will work and I will bet money it does not have a two-year warranty on it.
